

Hidden Harbour Lake Fishing Guidelines

Common Carp:

- Harvest all common carps when caught. Common carps are the most abundant species in the lake and provide no benefit to the fishery. Furthermore, they suck up the eggs of the bluegills before they hatch. Bluegills are the main food source for bass.

Bluegill and Redear Sunfish:

- Catch and Release. Discontinue bluegill and sunfish harvesting until the fishery is back to a well balanced condition. Both bluegill and sunfish are the primary forage species with bluegill being the most dominate forage species in the lake.

Largemouth Bass:

- Catch and release only

All Other Species:

- Catch and release

We ask all residents to adhere to the fishing guidelines. The quality of fishing at the lake depends on your cooperation. An excessive harvest of any species will only worsen our balance problem with the overall fishery.
